An ordinance amending Ordinance #488.

**Sec. IV. Administrative adjudication hearing.**

(a) A person who receives a notice of violation may contest the imposition of the civil penalty by a request in writing for an administrative adjudication of the civil penalty within thirty (30) calendar days inclusive of weekends and legal holidays after receipt of the notice of violation. Upon receipt of a timely request, the Police Department shall notify the person of the date and time of the administrative adjudication hearing.

(e) A person who is found liable after an administrative adjudication hearing or who requests an administrative adjudication hearing and thereafter fails to appear at the time and place of the hearing shall be liable for the entire penalty.
